



FOUR-BALL HANDICAP STABLEFORD COMPETITION

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

The following conditions for this competition must be read in conjunction with CAGU's General Conditions, which are published on the website (www.cagu.co.uk). When entering a competition players/clubs should, in particular, be aware of the General Conditions covering eligibility, entries and withdrawals.

The Local Rules applicable to the competition **are contained in England Golf's (which is also CAGU's) Hard Card. It also contains the Conditions on pace of play and suspension of play due to a dangerous situation. A copy of the card will be provided at registration.**

Note: After entries close, the Competition Organiser will send by e-mail (or, by exception, post) to each pair's nominated contact and to those officiating a "Players' Information" sheet and a drawsheet. The draw will also be posted on the website. Players Information will include such matters as contact details of the Competition Organiser and the Club, provision for practice rounds (if applicable) and catering arrangements at the venue.

1. The Competition

- a. **Format.** The Competition shall be played by 36 holes of four-ball handicap stableford. Each player shall play off 90% of his current playing handicap.
- b. **The maximum field** is 40 pairs. If the number of entries exceeds 40, General Condition 4b applies (entries accepted in order of their receipt).
- c. **The winners** shall be the pair returning the best stableford score over 36 holes. In the event of a tie, General Condition 18b (Countback) will apply.
- d. **All other ties** will likewise be decided according to General Condition 18b (Countback).
- e. **Player eligibility/qualification:** See General Condition 3. In addition, at date of entry, entrants must have a handicap not exceeding 20.4.

2. Winners and Prizes

- a. The winners shall receive winners' prizes.
- b. The runners up shall also receive prizes.
- c. Further prizes will normally be awarded, depending on the number of entries.
- D Where prizes are in the form of vouchers, their value shall be decided by the Competition Committee.
